#### **WAIKITE VALLEY SCHOOL SWIMMING SPORTS**

DATE: Thurs 20th February

TIME: 9.30am start (approx. 12.30pm finish)

All students compete in the age group for the age that they were on 28th January (the same as Cluster & SportBOP rules)

We strongly encourage all students aged 7-13 years old to take part in 1 length freestyle & backstroke. They can choose to take part in the 2 lengths and 4 lengths freestyle or backstroke. There is also the option for our 8-13

year olds to compete in the 1, 2 or 4 lengths of breaststroke races. We are very pleased to have Amy McMahon (SportBOP) to assist with judging on the day.

All whanau are welcome to attend for the day to cheer on the students. Please be aware that the program will run from start to finish, without break. We can only guarantee the start time of the day - everything after that is difficult to predict accurate timing, EXCEPT the 5-6 year old demonstration will will be done at 10.30am sharp. The students will have the opportunity to snack, toilet and drink water between races. We ask that all students stay under the shaded side of the pool when not swimming so they are sheltered from the sun and to ensure they do not miss any races.
