Futsal is indoor 5-a-side soccer played on a basketball sized court with 3m wide by 2m high goals. Each game has two 18-minute halves. Due to the small number of players required (five per team plus substitutes) it is easier for schools to find enough players for a team to give it a go.

A local school futsal competition will be run in term 4, 2024, on Sundays from 10:00am to 6:00pm at the Rotorua Girls' high School Arena in Rotorua. The competition is scheduled to run for seven weeks, starting October 20 and finishing December 8 (no games on Labour Day long weekend).

The competition is limited to a maximum of 60 teams so don't delay. Entry fee is \$175 per team for seven weeks (we provide referees as part of this entry fee).
